

MNA BOARD OF DIRECTORS HIGHLIGHTS July 18, 2024

- The BOD approved the 2024 MNA Award Recipients as recommended by the Awards Committee. Awardees will be recognized at the Awards Banquet at Convention on Tuesday, October 8th from 6-9pm.
- Convention will be held at Margaritaville Resort in Hyannis on October 8-10. - Steward Update: We continue to wait to see where we are at with the transition of the hospitals in Massachusetts. Bids were due by Monday, July 15th. We should find out more in the coming days.
- Dana Farber Boston ratified their tentative agreement. Brockton Hospital is planning on reopening on August 10th maternity and psych will open at a later date. They have been closed since their fire on February 7, 2023.
- Dominique Muldoon was appointed to the MNA Finance Committee.
- The BOD voted to revise the FY 2025 budget to include an additional \$1,000 for Region 3. Monies will also be moved from the Division of Legislation to Region 4 to cover the cost of membership in an additional Central Labor Council for members.
- The Public Communications Division walked through the MNA App and answered questions about iMIS. The BOD voted to initiate the process of hiring a dedicated employee solely for the purpose of managing the Association's app and website. They created a taskforce to establish things they would like to see implemented.
- The BOD approved the Policy Committee's recommended revisions to the following policies in Section 10: Appointments to AFL-CIO State and Central Labor Councils; Policies for Administration of the Emergency Relief Fund for Strike-Related Requests and for Employer Actions Against Bargaining Unit Members; Policy for Newly Organized Bargaining Unit Members and Organizing Policy Regarding Membership Requirement for Collective Bargaining Required Number for MNA Representation. They also approved revisions to the MNA Election and Campaign Rules Policy to reflect the current process.
- MNA will renew American Income Life, which provides a death benefit to members at no charge. They offer additional benefits that members can opt in to.
